From the Pastor...

Time certainly seems to be flying by. In a little over a week, we will find ourselves at the beginning of our Lenten journey. The reality is, this is actually later than most years, as Easter is not until April 17th this year. To help prepare us for the various observances and celebrations throughout the Lent and Holy Week, a card is being mailed out this week which highlights all of these liturgical activities. Over the past two years of COVID, some of the days and times have fluctuated – please pay special attention to when everything is scheduled to occur. One of the first things needed to begin the season of Lent our palms to prepare the ashes for Ash Wednesday. Please plan to bring your old palms to Church next weekend. There will be containers for them in the three vestibules. During the Lenten season, we will begin our Sunday Masses with an instrumental, and then the invitation for all to kneel for the Penitential Rite. We will also begin the practice of kneeling after the Lamb of God, in preparation to receive the

Holy Eucharist. As with the season of Advent, we will also use the two Eucharistic Prayers for Reconciliation during Lent.

Beginning with Ash Wednesday until Palm Sunday, those same containers will remain in the vestibules. We are asking you to consider bringing items for our **“Clean up your act for Lent”** collection of personal hygiene and household cleaning supplies. These items will be gathered together and distributed to those in need by Catholic Charities. Our Generations of Faith students and their families will be participating in a similar event in March. Another event we are very happy to announce is our first **“Green Eggs (or whatever color you want) and Ham Collection”**. Based on the incredible generosity demonstrated annually in the Thanksgiving Turkey Connection, we will be collecting whole or half hams (which do not need to be baked) for use at area soup kitchens for Easter dinners. The collection will be in the parish hall on the Wednesday of Holy Week, April 13th from 10:00am – 3:00pm. We are announcing it now so you can pick up a ham when they are on sale and plan to bring it that day. We will also be accepting any colored Easter eggs for soup kitchens, as well as any canned or boxed food items. While you will not be seeing the traditional Rice Bowls at the entrances this year, we are still very much a participant in this annual collection for Catholic Relief Services. The Holy Thursday envelope is part of this collection. We invite you to consider making a contribution via that offertory envelope to help accomplish the work of CRS, locally, and beyond.

Next weekend, in anticipation of Lent, we will also be announcing the **2022 Annual Diocesan Appeal – One in Hope, One in Mission**. This newly designed appeal replaces the former *Annual Bishop's Appeal*. The appeal continues to offer the majority of its funds for the work of charity through Catholic Charities. As in the past 20 plus years, a lesser portion of the appeal will fund the many diocesan ministries, which provide support and assistance to our parishes, schools, and other institutions. Saint Michael Parish has always been very responsive to this annual appeal in the past. Bishop Bonnar and I are counting on everyone to prayerfully make a response to the appeal. More information will be presented at the Masses next weekend, while previous donors are in the process of receiving information in the mail.

It is my most fervent prayer that this coming season of Lent will find us all prepared to **Pray to God, Fast for ourselves, and Give to others**. God bless you.
