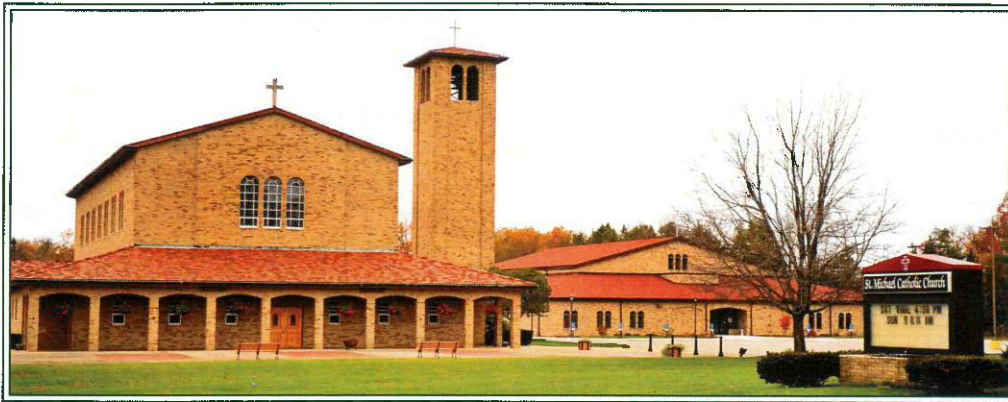

**FROM THE PASTOR . . .**

Today, as we bring to a close the Easter season with the Solemnity of Pentecost, we dedicate ourselves to the same work of those first believers, to go forth giving life to the church. I am so very grateful for the many ways in which the people of Saint Michael give of themselves – in prayer, in formation, and in service.

Our prayer, including the celebration of the Mass, always invites us into a deeper relationship with God. Like any relationship, it cannot become one sided, where the other is taken for granted. We must open our hearts and minds so as to discover the ways in which our Lord is calling us to receive his blessings, and, in turn, share them with others. This can only be realized in a mutual relationship with the Lord found in prayer, worship, and praise.

Our formation, like our prayer-life, never has an ending. Too often, people will boast of a Catholic grade school experience, or 8 years of CCD, or even the privilege of having gone to a Catholic high school. All of those are wonderful, but not an ending point. Imagine going to a doctor who boasts of a grade school or high school diploma – and nothing else – or a lawyer, or accountant, or teacher, or any other profession which requires advanced knowledge or training. Our life-long profession is to be a disciple of Christ, and as such, we must be of continual conversion and formation. Beginning this fall, we will be offering a series of adult faith formation sessions throughout the catechetical year. When advertised, please consider participating. Likewise, when we have additional liturgical celebrations, such as Advent and Lenten Vespers, Stations of the Cross, Nights to Honor Mary or the Saints – these are also moments of formation and discovery.

Our service as Christian brothers and sisters is essential to who we are as a People of God. I am very heartened by the variety of ways in which members of this community offer their time, talent, and treasure to make a difference in the lives of all in need. Over the summer, we will be mapping out a more concise calendar of collections, events, and opportunities to invite a greater response to our service of neighbor. One activity begun this past year was the social justice component to our Generations of Faith program. It was incredibly well received, and the outpouring of generosity has made a great difference in the lives of so many in our local area.

As we recall the first outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles, may we, confident of that same act in our own lives, receive with great joy the gifts and blessings of the Spirit, and go out to all the world – giving new life to the Church. God bless you all, Father Lavelle.

## *Born into a Family Baptized into a Faith*

Over the summer, we will be adding these two marble pieces of art to the sanctuary of our Church. Each is 3 feet wide and 9 feet tall (comprised of three 3 foot square panels) and made of Botticino marble, with gold leaf carvings – One of Saint Anne and the Child Mary, the other of Saint John the Baptizer and Jesus in the Jordan. These once graced a now closed Church in Cleveland, and will add greatly to lighten our sanctuary and provide examples of how we are all born into a family, and baptized into a faith. The panels will be placed one the brick walls which extend into the sanctuary from the Holy Family Shrine and the Blessed Sacrament. The installation is scheduled for sometime this summer. If you are interested in sponsoring either piece of art, the cost of purchasing them and installing them is \$2,500 each. Should you be interested, please contact the parish office. May the image of Mary and her mother foster greater love of family, and the image of Christ's own baptism inspire deeper faith in us all.
