FROM THE PASTOR . . .



Beginning this weekend, there will be a special "second collection" on the 2nd weekend of each month. This will allow anyone and everyone to participate in providing the new statue of our parish patron, Saint Michael, for our Church. The carving will be created in Italy and will be positioned in the area to the right of the Tabernacle as a Shrine to Saint Michael. Thank you in advance for your combined generosity to this project. Our plan is to have both this Shrine and the Stained-Glass Gallery Windows blessed by Bishop Bonnar on our Feast Day in September.



Today is the feast of Saint Columba, who serves as the principal patron of the Diocese of Youngstown. When the diocese was established in 1943, the parish Church of Saint Columba was chosen from the many in the city to serve as the new Cathedral. Born in 521, most likely in Donegal Ireland of royal descent he studied at Moville under Saint Finnian then in Leinster at the monastery of Clonard under another St. Finnian. He was ordained before he was twenty-five and spent the next fifteen years preaching and setting up foundations at Derry, Durrow, and Kells. Possibly because of a family feud which resulted in the death of 3000 and for which he considered himself partly responsible he left Ireland at age 42 and landed on the island of Iona off the coast of Scotland. There he built the monastery which was to become world famous. With Saints Canice and Comgall he spread the gospel to the Picts; he also developed a monastic rule which many followed until the introduction of Saint Benedict. He died on Iona. Last year, Bishop Bonnar and I led a pilgrimage to Scotland and Ireland. One of the highlights of the trip was celebrating Mass at Saint Columba's Monastery in Iona on his Feast Day. May Saint Columba inspire us all in our missionary efforts to bring Christ to others.

O God, by the preaching of your blessed servant **Columba** you caused the light of the Gospel to shine in Scotland: Grant, we pray, that, having his life and labors in remembrance, we may show our thankfulness to you by following the example of his zeal and patience; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever. Amen.

ED CHOICE SCHOLARSHIP

As a result of Ohio House Bill 33, signed into law on July 4, 2023, all K-12 students in Ohio are now eligible for an EdChoice Scholarship that can be used toward Catholic school tuition. This includes currently enrolled children as well as any new student beginning their Catholic school experience this fall.

The EdChoice Scholarship will cover a portion, or in some cases, the full cost of a family's Catholic A student's specific EdChoice school tuition. amount depends on the family's 2023 gross adjusted income and family size. The amount could be as much as \$6,166 per year for a student in grades K-8, and \$8,408 per year for a student in grades 9-12.

Returning families are already aware of the value of Catholic education. Families interested in pursuing a Catholic education for the first time should contact the local Catholic school principal who will be happy to assist you. Availability for new enrollments will vary by location: doy.org/schools/contact.
