

FROM THE PASTOR



The Ascension does not mark the end of Jesus' relationship with His Church but the beginning of a new way of His relating to the world - in and through His Church. This way includes every one of us who now bear His name. When viewed with the eyes of living faith the Ascension can begin to change the way we view ourselves and live our daily lives. The Ascension invites us to reflect on who Jesus is - and who we are empowered to become in Him, beginning now and opening up into the life to come. He is indeed the Way, the Truth and the Life. The Feast of the Ascension of the Lord Jesus helps to explain the Christian vocation and unveils the horizon which opens before us as we continue to live our lives now in this Way called Christianity. It points to the ongoing plan of redemption for each of us. It gives us a glimpse of the loving plan of God for the whole of creation. For most of the life of the Church, the Ascension of the Lord was celebrated on Thursday. In most of the country, the Feast has been transferred to Sunday. However, whether celebrated on Thursday or Sunday, it is meant to be a cause for celebration. It can be - If we allow the Holy Spirit to show us what it really means. The Ascension is meant to be a Feast of profound meaning, hope and promise. He is indeed the Way, the Truth and the Life. (John 14:6) This Feast also points us toward a deeper understanding of the Feast of Pentecost which we will celebrate next Sunday. The gift at that Spirit makes it possible for us to live differently beginning right now. It is at work within us. transforming us more and more into His Image and Likeness, as we cooperate with the gift of grace. This new Way is meant to begin in the here and now, to be completed in the fullness of time.

May the Risen Christ, ascended to the Father, lead us one day to live with him eternally in the Kingdom of Heaven.
