

On Saturday, June 7, 2025, the Most Reverend David J. Bonnar, Bishop of Youngstown, ordained Reverend Travis Seagraves to the Order of the Priesthood of Jesus Christ. Father Seagraves was a transitional deacon at Our Lady of Peace Parish in Ashtabula.

We extend our sincere congratulations to Father Seagraves on his ordination to the priesthood and wish him well in his new assignment.

PENTECOST

Pentecost is one of the great festivals of the Church. In modern popular culture it isn't nearly as well known as Christmas or Easter, but for Christians it's profoundly significant. It marks the coming of the Holy Spirit on the disciples and their transformation from frightened and confused people to men who would face martyrdom for what they believed. Three important understandings of our celebration are:

- 1. Pentecost means '50': Pentecost is from the Greek word 'Pentekostos', which means 'fifty'. It's the 50th day after the Sabbath of Passover week and in Judaism is called the Feast of Weeks. (Leviticus 23:16).
- 2. Pentecost is the fulfilment of two promises: One promise is in the Old Testament <u>Joel 2:28</u>, which says "I will pour out my Spirit on all people", and one in the New, where Jesus says he will send another Counsellor, the Spirit of truth. (John 16: 5-15).
- **3. Pentecost is the birthday of the Church.** It marks the beginning of Christianity as a purposeful movement and a new community. When Peter preached immediately afterwards, around 3,000 people believed and were baptized.

May the celebration of Pentecost challenge us to live a more vibrant faith as we give life to the Church each and every day. Alleluia!

SEVEN GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

Wisdom:

Enables one to discern God's will and to make wise decisions.

Understanding:

Allows for a deeper grasp of God's truth and the mysteries of faith.

Counsel:

Provides guidance in making decisions and helping others.

Fortitude:

Gives strength and courage to endure difficulties and stand firm in one's faith.

Knowledge:

Grants a deeper understanding of God's Word and the world.

Piety:

Inspires reverence, respect, and devotion to God.

Fear of the Lord:

Not a fearful awe, but rather a reverence and humility before God's holiness.

SPONSOR GUIDELNE FOR BAPTISM AND CONFIRMATION

It is an honor to be asked to be a sponsor (godparent) for Baptism or Confirmation. It means that you are seen as someone who is practicing their faith and living a life that reflects the teachings of the Catholic faith. Sponsors need to be:

- Registered in a parish. (adult children, 25 years old, need to be registered independently)
- 2. Attending Mass regularly at their parish of registration.
- 3. If married, a valid marriage recognized by the Catholic Church.
- 4. Forming their children in the faith. (religious education or Catholic School)

You will be asked to submit a letter of eligibility as a sponsor, signed by the pastor of your current parish. These are universal norms for the Catholic faith, found in Canon Law (nos. 872-874).

"I cannot deny that it is necessary to be honest and recognize that the most effective solutions will not come from individual efforts alone, but above all from major political decisions on the national and international level.

Carpool and consolidate trips.


