#### FROM THE PASTOR ...

Each year on the First Sunday of Lent, we hear one of the three synoptic Gospel versions of Jesus being temped by Satan in the desert. In this year of Mark, we reflect on his rather brief, but powerful depiction. The powerful statement at the conclusion has Jesus reminding the Apostles, and us, that the "This is the time of fulfilment. The Kingdom of God is at hand". Then we hear the same words we heard this past Wednesday when we were marked with the sign of the cross in ashes - "Repent and believe in the Gospel". This holy season of Lent calls us to a greater sense of repentance by searching our hearts and minds and discovering the ways in which we have removed Christ from the center of our lives and placed ourselves there instead. May this season challenge us to invite a conversion of heart and center ourselves on Christ and his teachings, remembering that in following him more faithfully, the Kingdom of God will be at hand for each of us.

#### PARISH LENTEN MISSION

We have the opportunity to participate in a threeday Lenten Mission here at Saint Michael Parish. You are welcome to participate in all three days, or whatever days work for you. The Mission will be Monday, February 26<sup>th</sup>, Tuesday, February 27<sup>th</sup>, and Wednesday, February 28<sup>th</sup>. Each evening will begin at 7:00pm and provide an opportunity for specific forms of prayer.

#### Monday - February 26th - Stations of the Cross

On this evening, we will celebrate the Stations of the Cross, interspersed with reflections of various Titles of the Lord. As we journey to the tomb, reflecting on the thoughts held in the heart and mind of the Blessed Mother as she journeyed with her Son to Calvary, we will also be able to reflect more deeply on various titles attributed to Christ that we can call upon in our own personal prayer.

#### Tuesday, February 27th - Eucharistic Holy Hour

On this evening, we will have a Holy Hour with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. During this hour, we will join in song, psalms, Scripture readings and reflections, as well as silent meditation, all before the True Presence of our Lord. This important form of prayer and Eucharistic devotion is not always invited by many into their personal prayer life, but is essential to our relationship with Jesus in the Eucharist.

## Wednesday, February 28<sup>th</sup> Lenten Reconciliation Service

On this evening, we will have the opportunity to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation as we seek a clean heart in preparation for the celebration of the Paschal Mystery at Easter. Several priests will be with us as we join in prayer, song, and Scripture, as well as the graced time of personal confession.

#### STATIONS OF THE CROSS

On the Fridays of Lent (February 23, March 1, 8, 15, and 22), Mass will be held at 8:00am followed by Mary's Way of the Cross at 8:30.

#### **ANNUAL DIOCESAN APPEAL**

Today's Gospel said that Jesus "remained in the desert for forty days" (Mark 1:13, emphasis added). Remaining with Jesus in the desert is not easy. (Welcome to Lent).

Further driving home how difficult it is to follow him, in Luke's Gospel, Jesus warns, "If anyone wishes to come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily" (Luke 9:23). Yet on another note, in John's Gospel, Jesus commands us, "Remain in my love" (John 15:9). Remaining in Jesus' love isn't easy, either—especially when it involves the desert.

Feeling like it's too difficult to do this by ourselves is okay. It' soften exactly where God wants us—because it pushes us to rely on him. That can be a place of profound growth. Our parish, and those we serve, relies on you to help us meet our many needs and the needs of our community. As you lift the cross Jesus asks of you this Lent, please remember our Annual Diocesan Appeal. We are counting on you. This Lent, count on us, and count on God! We'll walk in the desert with you,


