In the Acts of the Apostles this weekend, we hear:

Peter said to the people: "The God of Abraham. the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, the God of our fathers, has glorified his servant Jesus, whom you handed over and denied in Pilate's presence when he had decided to release him. As we continue in this Easter season, may we also continue a little of our Lenten discipline of seeking repentance and forgiveness for our sins.


