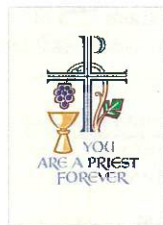

PRAYER FOR MEMORIAL DAY

Father as we observe Memorial Day this Monday, hold our troops, our reserves, and our veterans in your loving hands. Protect them as they protect us. Bless them and their families for the selfless acts they perform for us in all lands and on all seas. Bring to eternal life those who have died defending our country in every decade of our country's history. Amen.

PENTECOST

Pentecost is one of the great festivals of the Church. In modern popular culture it isn't nearly as well known as Christmas or Easter, but for Christians it's profoundly significant. It marks the coming of the Holy Spirit on the disciples and their transformation from frightened and confused people to men who would face martyrdom for what they believed. Three important understandings of our celebration are:
1. Pentecost means '50': Pentecost is from the Greek word 'Pentekostos', which means 'fifty'. It's the 50th day after the Sabbath of Passover week and in Judaism is called the Feast of Weeks. (Leviticus 23:16).

2. Pentecost is the fulfilment of two promises: One promise is in the Old Testament – Joel 2:28, which says "I will pour out my Spirit on all people", and one in the New, where Jesus says he will send another Counsellor, the Spirit of truth. (John 16: 5-15).

3. Pentecost is the birthday of the Church.: It marks the beginning of Christianity as a purposeful movement and a new community. When Peter preached immediately afterwards, around 3,000 people believed and were baptized. May the celebration of Pentecost challenge us to live a more vibrant faith as we give life to the Church each and every day. Alleluia!

CHURCH AT HOME COMBINED COLLECTION

Next weekend, parishes in the Diocese of Youngstown will hold the annual CHURCH AT HOME combined collection. This three-in-one collection supports the national and local work of three important Church ministries. The Catholic Campaign for Human Development works to break the cycles of poverty by providing local and national support for low-income people with a hand up, not a handout. The USCCB Catholic Communication Campaign helps the Church spread the Gospel message through local and national media. The Catholic University of America and Newman Campus Ministries supports educational and research programs and develops future leaders at the national university of our Catholic Church. 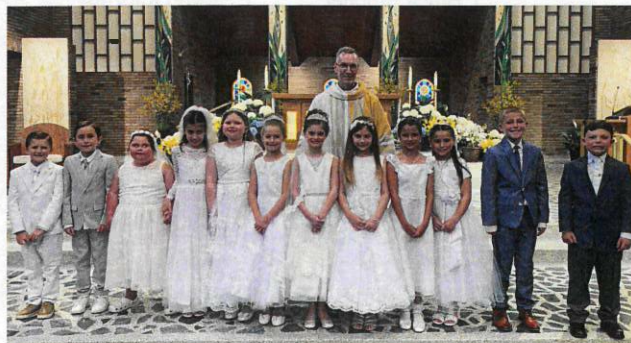

"Receive the Holy Spirit!" The words spoken to the Apostles on that first day of the week are spoken to us as we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost – The Birth of the Church. Throughout the Easter season, we have journeyed week after week with the Acts of the Apostles – the work of the early Church. We are called to model ourselves after their labors: to increase the number of believers, to devote ourselves to the sharing of the Word, and to be of service to others so that no one goes without. One of the opportunities provided for us to model that attribute of the early Church's care for those in need is through the **Annual Diocesan Appeal: One in Hope, One in Mission**. A little over a week ago, we reached the **\$3,000,000** mark in our \$4,000,000 Appeal goal. While this is great news, the last million is always the hardest to raise. To date, our parish family has pledged **\$111,014** toward our parish goal of **\$107,000**. This is from less than 20% of our registered households. Recently, letters went out to 4,000 households who made a gift last year but had yet done so this year. We are already receiving wonderful responses to that request. If you received one of those letters, please take some time to prayerfully reflect on your ability to make a gift. Every gift of any amount helps put us closer to the goal. On behalf of Bishop Bonnar and those served by the Appeal, thank you to everyone who has already made a gift and to those who are prayerfully considering their gift. As members of the One Church – Happy Birthday! May the Spirit of God dwell in and through us every day.

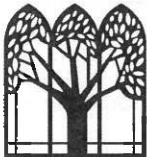
