### ANNUAL DIOCESAN APPEAL One in Hope, One in Mission

If we were able to add just another 100 parishioners to the list of generous donors this year, the difference that could mean to our brothers and sisters in need in the area would be amazing. More information will be presented next weekend, and in the coming weeks.

#### REAL PRESENCE BOOK STUDY


