FROM THE PASTOR...

On this Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, Bishop Bonnar and I, together with 42 other pilgrims from the Diocese of Youngstown and beyond, are celebrating Mass at the Basilica of Our Lady of Knock. Thank you to Father Korda for celebrating the weekend Masses with you, and to Deacon John, as he celebrates his last weekend as a Deacon before his Ordination to the Priesthood next Saturday. Please be assured of my continued prayers for the entire parish family of Saint Michael at each Church and Shrine we visit, especially when we celebrated the Feast of Saint Columba this past Friday at the Abbey Church founded by our diocesan patron. I look forward to sharing some of the highlights with all of you when I return. FEAST OF THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

In 1246, Bishop Robert de Thorete of the Belgian diocese of Liège, at the suggestion of St. Juliana of Mont Cornillon (also in Belgium), convened a synod and instituted the celebration of the feast. From Liège, the celebration began to spread, and, on September 8, 1264, Pope Urban IV issued the papal bull "Transiturus," which established the Feast of Corpus Christi as a universal feast of the Church, to be celebrated on the Thursday following Trinity Sunday.

At the request of Pope Urban IV, St. Thomas Aquinas composed the office (the official prayers of the Church) for the feast. This office is widely considered one of the most beautiful in the traditional Roman Breviary (the official prayer book of the Divine Office or Liturgy of the Hours), and it is the source of the famous Eucharistic hymns *Pange Lingua Gloriosi* and *Tantum Ergo Sacramentum*.

For centuries after the celebration was extended to the universal Church, the feast was also celebrated with a Eucharistic procession, in which the Sacred Host was carried throughout the town, accompanied by hymns and litanies. The faithful would venerate the Body of Christ as the procession passed by. In recent years, this practice has almost disappeared, though some parishes still hold a brief procession around the outside of the parish church.

While the Feast of Corpus Christi is one of the ten Holy Days of Obligation in the Latin Rite of the Catholic Church, in some countries, including the United States, the feast has been transferred to the following Sunday.

Registration has begun for our new Youth Faith Formation Program (YFF) for Kindergarten through Eighth Grade. Please note that registration for YFF will continue through September 1st.

Sacrament reminders: The diocese of Youngstown requires two years of formation before the reception of sacraments. First and Second grades are required for First Reconciliation and First Eucharist. Seventh and Eighth grades are required for confirmation. Please keep in mind that if your child misses any years between Second grade and Seventh grade, it is possible they will not be invited into Confirmation preparations in Eighth grade.

Kindergarten is a great head start for faith formation. We highly recommend Kindergarten as a first step in the formation process for our youngest learners.

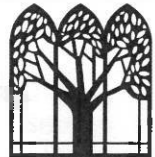
