#### **ED CHOICE SCHOLARSHIP**

As a result of Ohio House Bill 33, signed into law on July 4, 2023, all K-12 students in Ohio are now eligible for an EdChoice Scholarship that can be used toward Catholic school tuition. This includes currently enrolled children as well as any new student beginning their Catholic school experience this fall.

The EdChoice Scholarship will cover a portion, or in some cases, the full cost of a family's Catholic school tuition. A student's specific EdChoice amount depends on the family's 2023 gross adjusted income and family size. The amount could be as much as \$6,166 per year for a student in grades K-8, and \$8,408 per year for a student in grades 9-12.

Returning families are already aware of the value of Catholic education. Families interested in pursuing a Catholic education for the first time should contact the local Catholic school principal who will be happy to assist you. Availability for new enrollments will vary by location: doy.org/schools/contact.

#### FROM THE PASTOR...

This Saturday, the 22nd of June, is the Feast Day of two great Saints - John Fischer and Thomas More. One a Bishop and the other a statesman in England - they both were sentenced to death for upholding the sanctity of Holy Matrimony in the face of King Henry VIII seeking to divorce one wife and marry another, all in the hopes of having a male heir for his kingdom. Henry's short-sightedness not only pulled an entire nation out of union with the Catholic Church, but ultimately failed in his immediate hopes. Sadly the new wife would only give him a daughter that lived. His third wife would finally give him a son, but she would die in childbirth and the son would not live past the age of 15. The daughter from his second marriage would go on to be Elizabeth I. Together with Victoria and Elizabeth II, these three women would emerge as some of the greatest rulers in Great Britain's history, ruling for a combined total of nearly 179 years. Perhaps the message is when faced with decisions whether to follow God's will in our lives, or our own desires -Saint Thomas More said it best in his last words: "I die the King's good servant – but God's first!".

## SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION IN THE PARISH




