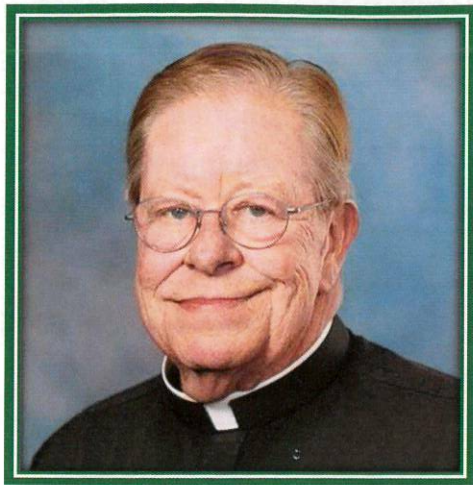


ANNUAL DIOCESAN APPEAL
