LAETARE SUNDAY

Today is the halfway mark of the Sundays of Lent. This Sunday is known as *Laetare* Sunday for the first word of the Introit or Entrance Antiphon *laetare* (rejoice):

Rejoice ye with Jerusalem; and be ye glad for her, all ye that delight in her: exult and sing for joy with her, all ye that in sadness mourn for her; that ye may suck, and be satisfied with the breasts of her consolations.

This year, the Gospel reminds us that Jesus Christ is the light that came into the world, and yet, many chose to live in darkness. Perhaps this year's celebration of Laetare Sunday and this Gospel are perfectly positioned as we Spring Ahead and experience an increase of daylight. May these remaining weeks of our Lenten season become for us an opportunity to bring that increasing light of Christ not only to ourselves, but to those we encounter, through our prayers, acts of charity, and self-denial.

Jesus says in today's Gospel that "Whoever lives the truth comes to the light, so that his works may be clearly seen as done in God" (John 3:21).
