

#### YOU NEVER KNOW

This coming Friday, we as a Church celebrate Saint Scholastica, the sister of Saint Benedict, who consecrated her life to God from her earliest youth. After her brother went to Monte Cassino and established his monastery, she founded and governed a monastery of nuns, about five miles from that of Saint Benedict. She visited her brother once a year, and as she was not allowed to enter his monastery, he went in company with some of his brethren to meet her at a house some distance away. These visits were spent conferring together on spiritual matters. On one occasion they had passed the time as usual in prayer and pious conversation and in the evening they sat down to take their reflection. Saint Scholastica begged her brother to remain until the next day. Saint Benedict refused to spend the night outside his monastery. She had recourse to prayer and a furious thunderstorm burst so that neither Saint Benedict nor any of his companions could return home. They spent the night in spiritual conferences. The next morning, they parted to meet no more on earth. Three days later Saint Scholastica died, and her holy brother beheld her soul in a vision as it ascended into heaven. He sent his brethren to bring her body to his monastery and laid it in the tomb he had prepared for himself. She died about the year 543, and Saint Benedict followed her soon after.

I share this story not only to help us celebrate the life of Saint Scholastica, but to remind us of the many opportunities we have to spend a little more time in prayer and conversation with someone. How often we hear from people, "I wish I could have just one more talk with them, or one more afternoon with them", after someone is gone. I am certain that Saint Benedict reflected on that last conversation with his sister after he heard she died. And no doubt, was so grateful for her insistence that he stay. What is our response to those closest to us when they need just a few moments of our time? You never know!

#### YOUNG AT HEART

Our monthly Young at Heart gathering will be on Monday, February 13<sup>th</sup>. As always, we will begin with Mass at 11:30am, and then have lunch and a presentation to follow in the parish hall. Given the date of our gathering, we will combine Valentine's Day and Mardi Gras to reflect on the Saint associated with love and then also look at some of the ways in which we are called to enter the Lenten Journey. #### LIGHTING PROJECT

As mentioned in the bulletin a few weeks ago, we are still waiting for the chandeliers and the lighting panel (the brains of the whole project), to be shipped. I am extremely grateful for everyone who has generously sponsored parts of the project. To date, the lighting panel, the sanctuary lighting, the five main entrance chandeliers, three of the large center chandeliers, one of entire side lighting, and the lights on the Archangels Window and the Risen Christ, have been sponsored. That leaves just one side of lighting (\$6,000) and five (5) large center chandeliers (\$10,000 each) to be sponsored. Thank you to parishioners who have donated in general to the project. If anyone is interested in sponsoring one of the remaining parts of the project, please contact the parish office. Once this project is completed, the names of those sponsoring the project will be included with those who sponsored the recent additions to the sanctuary (mosaics, marble panels, etc.) and placed on plaques similar to the existing ones for the Sainted Glass Windows and Stations of the Cross. I want to also thank Jeff and Amy Herrmann and their family for sponsoring the Holy Spirit mosaic to be added above the Tabernacle. Thank you to everyone for your generous support of our parish Church.


