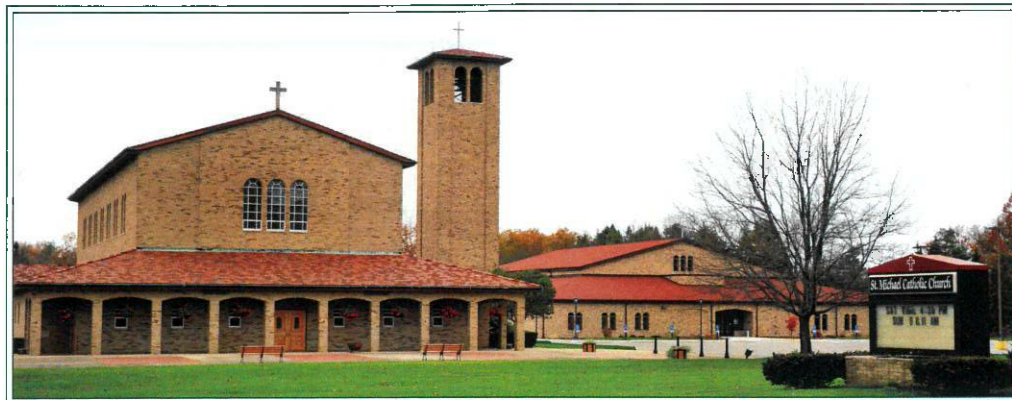

NEW CHURCH LIGHTING

We will hopefully SEE, no pun intended, the new lighting begin to be installed in February. Like most of the world, we have experienced a delay in the center chandeliers and the new lighting panel. Once everything is in, we will determine the schedule for installation, with regard to holding daily Mass in the parish hall, and possibly for a weekend or two, weekend Masses in the FLC. Having all the equipment, such as the lift and scaffolding come down on Fridays and go back up on Mondays not only wastes time but adds cost to the project. Thank you to everyone who has sponsored this well needed project. There are still a few small chandeliers in the front entrance and larger chandeliers in the main body of the Church available for sponsorship. If you are interested, please contact the parish office. January Adult Faith Formation

This January, we are very happy to welcome the Diocesan Director of Peace and Justice, R. J. Mangan, to Saint Michael for a presentation on the legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., and the Catholic Peace and Justice Movement. Mr. Mangan works with Catholic Charities to promote the themes of Catholic Social Teaching, particularly the dignity of the human person, through education, advocacy, and prayer. Please join us on **Wednesday, January 18, at 6:30 pm in the Parish Hall**, for Mr. Mangan's presentation. It should be a wonderful opportunity to reinvigorate our commitment to the Church's social mission.

BY THE POWER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

In Eucharistic Prayer II, we hear these words "Make holy, therefore, these gifts, we pray, by sending down your Spirit upon them like the dewfall". These words, while somewhat different in each Eucharistic Prayer, is referred to as the "Epiclesis" – the calling down of the Holy Spirit. Uniting the Trinity, we implore God the Father to send God the Spirit, to provide us with the nourishment of God the Son. The image below is a beautiful mosaic of the sending down of the Holy Spirit, in the form of a dove, much like we hear at the Lord's Baptism. While the mosaic looks as if it was made for our Church, it is actually from a Church in Cleveland no longer used for worship. While there is sadness in many Churches being shuttered, one joy is that the treasures of the past which convey a call to prayer and devotion can be utilized in other Churches, much like the Risen Lord over the front entrance of our worship space, or the marble panels of the Baptism of the Lord and Saint Anne and the Virgin Mary now in the sanctuary. This mosaic is approximately 48" wide and 30" high. Given its striking resemblance to the mosaic Stations of the Cross installed over 20 years ago, and the recently updated mosaics in the sanctuary, it is our hope to install this mosaic above the tabernacle. While the current banner helps to set off the space reserved for the Blessed Sacrament, this mosaic will work not only to tie in all the other mosaics in the Church but will provide both permanence and beauty to the space. The cost of obtaining, cleaning, and installing the mosaic is \$4,000. If anyone is interested in sponsoring this work of art, please contact the parish office. Thank you, and may the Holy Spirit continue to descend upon us and guide us always.
