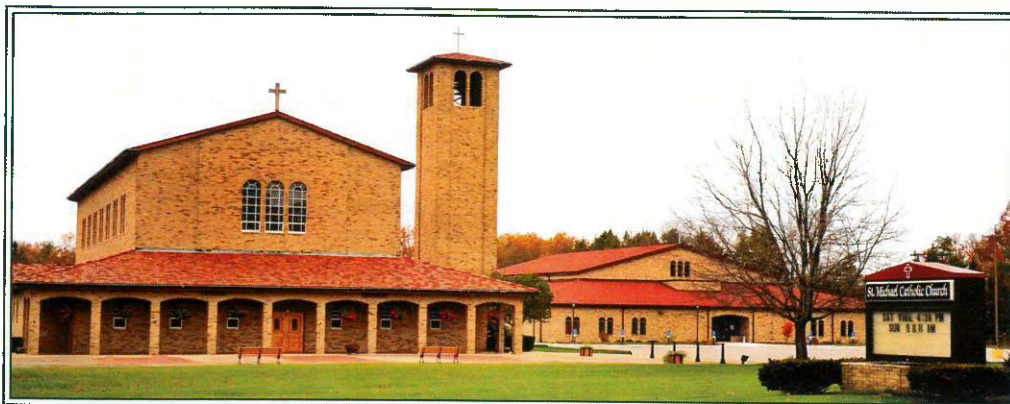

ANNUAL DIOCESAN APPEAL

Happy Anniversary to everyone! 79 years ago this very day, Pope Pius XII established the Diocese of Youngstown. For nearly eight decades, the People of God throughout our six counties have been blessed to receive the Word of God and the Body of Christ, and then go forth, sharing that grace in mission and ministry. The organized social service efforts of the diocese actually predate the official establishment of the diocese. For *more* than 8 decades, those in need have been shown great love and compassion by Catholic Charities through the support and encouragement of all our diocesan families. A great way to celebrate our 79th anniversary is by announcing that our Annual Diocesan Appeal – One in Hope, One in Mission, has reached the \$3,000,000 mark. This is 75% of our \$4,000,000 goal. What a great job! Thank you to everyone who has contributed to the Appeal to get us to this point. Here in our parish, we have received **\$85,096 (81.5%) of our \$104,300 parish goal.** This is from 247 of our registered families. If you have not yet made a pledge, please consider doing so between now and the end of the month. We need to meet the diocesan goal of \$4,000,000 to continue the great works of Catholic Charities and the mission of the Church. Thank you again, and Happy Anniversary to us all!

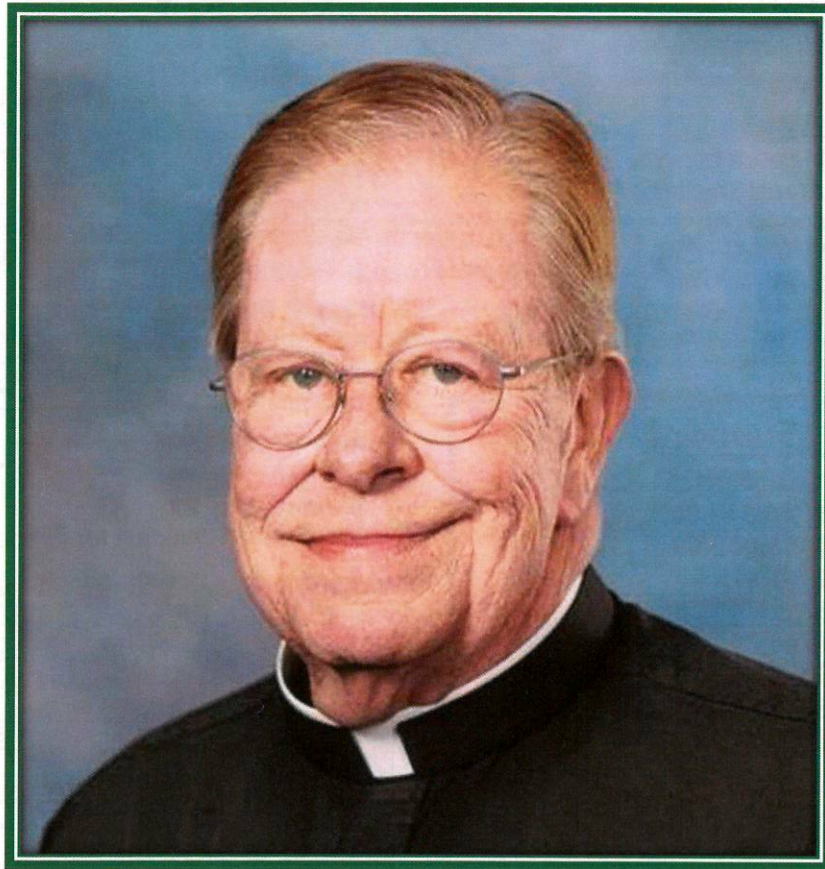

In 1962 President John F. Kennedy proclaimed May 15th as National Peace Officer Memorial Day, and the calendar week in which May 15th falls as National Police Week. During this week every year, we in the law enforcement profession honor our brothers and sisters who have made the ultimate sacrifice in service to their communities.

During this week, you will notice police officers wearing a mourning band on their badge. You will also notice blue ribbons tied to antennas of police cruisers. On the 15th, from sunrise to sunset, flags will be flown at half-staff at all government buildings. There will be memorial services around the country, and a Candlelight Vigil held in Washington, D.C. where the names of the fallen have been carved into the National Law Enforcement Officer Memorial.
