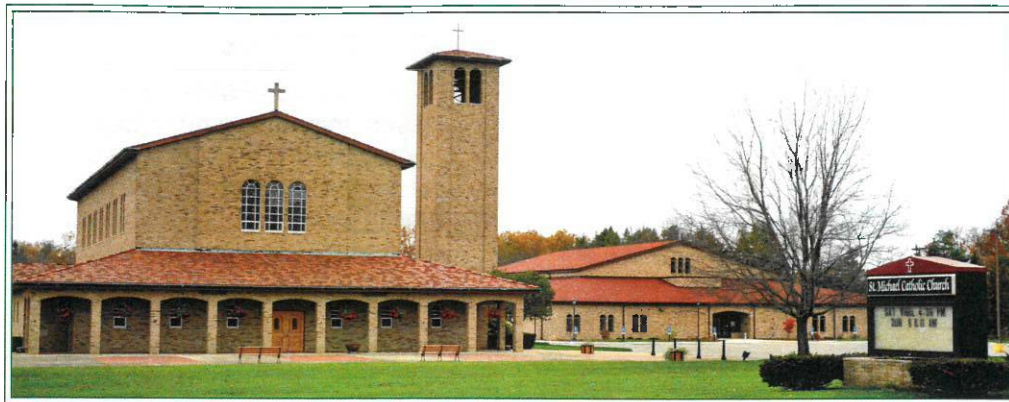

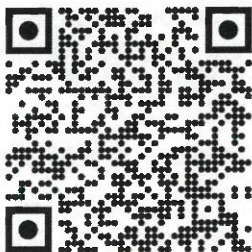

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION FOR ADULTS

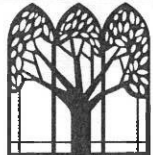

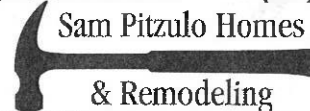
