**St. Joseph**: Donated in honor of Joseph R. and Mary Elizabeth Webster by Randall T. Webster, this window shows St. Joseph, Mary's husband, who cared for both Mary and Jesus. He was "a righteous man" (Matthew 1:18).

Although we know little about his life, Joseph is often portrayed in art as an old man. Our Joseph has white hair and a white beard. He wears a brown garment covered by a white cloak. His right hand shows an outstretched palm, and in his right hand he seems to be carrying a book. Or is it something else? Saint Joseph is the patron saint of carpenters (since that was his profession), of the dying, and of the universal Church. His feast day falls on March 19.
