

FROM THE PASTOR . . .

This week, the Church marks two different observances focusing on two different mothers. The first of these mothers is celebrated in many ways throughout the year - Mary, our Blessed Mother. Having celebrated her in the Solemnity of the Assumption this past Thursday, this coming Thursday, we observe the Queenship of Mary. Having been assumed into heaven, she takes her rightful place as Queen of Heaven. Like a good and loving mother, she takes her place near her Son to intercede on our behalf. As faithful Catholics in every generation, we are encouraged to bring our prayers to her, trusting she will carry them to the heart of Jesus. How blessed we are to have such a model of goodness and generosity as our Mother in Heaven.

On Tuesday, August 27, the church observes the memorial of Saint Monica. Saint Monica is the mother of one of the great theologians in the history

of the church, Saint Augustine of Hippo. But he didn't start out such great saint. While legend has Monica's years of tears finally securing his conversion, it is true that he spent many years living a life of grave sin, much like his own father. After many years, finally with the assistance of Saint Ambrose (through Monica's intercession), Augustine converted to the faith and lived a life completely focused on the Lord.

Both mothers lived lives centered on their sons. And both mothers did so through their faith in God, the Almighty Father. Mary's trust in God brought Christ into the world. Monica's trust in God had her pray and work unceasingly for her son's conversion. Let us each, regardless of gender or role, invite the example of both Mary and Monica into our lives. May we strive to place our complete trust in God, following his will, and remain faithful to him always. And may our journey of faith serve as an invitation, not an obstacle to gathering others to a life of discipleship.

The placement of these two observances is preceded and followed by the Sunday obligation of Mass. It is here that our response to be more faithful to God is strengthened. We gather in Word and Sacrament to be sent forth on Mission and Ministry. The work of securing individuals to be more faithful to God is not the work of Mary or Monica alone. We are called to share in this mission. Take time this week to pray over someone you need to invite back to Church. Ask them to join you next weekend for the celebration of Mass. May the trust and faithfulness of Mary, and the constant prayers of Monica inspire us to draw ever closer to the Lord, and invite others to the same journey, which ultimately leads us to stand with Monica, Augustine, and all the Saints before our Risen Lord, in the company of Mary, the Queen of Heaven.

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION FOR ADULTS



The celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation for adults will be held on Sunday, November 24, at 4:00pm at Saint Columba Cathedral. This is a special opportunity for anyone (age 18 or older) who has not received the

sacrament to join with other adults of the diocese.

Candidates must register with our parish and be eligible to receive the sacrament by verifying baptism and marital status. A preparation program will be held at our parish. Sponsors must be a baptized, confirmed, practicing Catholic and may not be the candidate's parent.



The Diocese of Youngstown is sponsoring a Wedding Anniversary Celebration on Sunday, October 27, at 2:00pm at the Basilica of Saint


John the Baptist in Canton, honoring couples observing their 25th, 40th, 50th and over wedding anniversaries in 2024.

NEXT WEEKEND WE WELCOME FATHER MOSE CHRISANTUS KEENGWE

Father Keengwe is a part of the Comboni Missionaries which he joined in 2006. He has been director of a school, a parish priest and is currently opening a new mission in Kenya where he will construct a church, a rectory and a small school. There he will provide evangelization, education and workshops to the children and parents of the area.

The Comboni Missionaries of the Heart of Jesus were founded in 1867 by Saint Daniel Comboni, the first Bishop of Central Africa. Today, the Comboni Missionaries number close to 1,500 with an equal number of Comboni Missionary Sisters. Together, they serve in over forty countries in Africa, Europe, the Americas and Asia.

The Comboni Missionaries remain true to their original calling as missionaries, and often serve where the Church is new and where people are just forming their Christian identity. They also serve in marginalized communities, including some of the most impoverished places on earth. Their parishes can be the size of American states or within the slums of the developing world. Emphasis is given to evangelization, and to service to people who are poor, many of whom have no place else to turn.

Funds collected through the Missionary Cooperative Plan are directed to projects in Africa and Latin America to evangelize, to educate (especially girls and young women), and to create better living conditions, through clinics and the provision of clean water. Beneficiaries range from street vendors in Peru to the Pygmies in the Central African Republic to desert dwellers in Ethiopia, Eritrea and Kenya.

We will have a second collection the weekend of August 24 & 25 to support the Comboni Missionaries.
