



PRAYER FOR PRIESTLY VOCATIONS



This Sunday, in addition to the 18th Sunday in Time. the Universal Church Ordinary commemorates Saint Jean Marie Vianney (August 4th). Known as the Cure of Ars, he stands as an outstanding model of priestly dedication and service in the Church. Taught to memorize his prayers from his mother, he struggled to finally achieve his dream of becoming a priest. Having given his whole life for God and his parishioners, John Vianney died on the 4th of August in 1859. He was 73 years old. His relics can be found in Ars, France, in the sanctuary dedicated to him, which is visited by some 450,000 pilgrims every year. He was beatified by Pope Saint Pius X in 1905 and canonized twenty years later by Pope Pius XI. In 1929, the same Pope proclaimed him the "heavenly patron of all parish priests throughout the world." During the centenary of his death in 1959, Pope Saint John XXIII dedicated an encyclical to St John Vianney, pointing him out as exemplary model for priests. Fifty years later, Pope Benedict XVI inaugurated a "Year of Priests" on the 150th anniversary of his birthday into heaven, in order "to deepen the commitment of all priests to interior renewal for the sake of a stronger and more incisive witness to the Gospel in today's world."

As we commemorate this patron of parish priests, I invite your prayers for all the priests of our diocese, that they may continue to minister faithfully to the people of God. Pray especially for our Bishop, David Bonnar, that he may continue to serve the local Church of Youngstown with a renewed sense of zeal and enthusiasm, striving "that all may be Pray in a special way for our eight seminarians returning to the seminary very soon, and all discerning a vocation to the priesthood, recalling the words "without priests, there is no Eucharist, without the Eucharist, there is no Church". I also humbly ask your prayers for me, that in both my ministry to Saint Michael as your pastor, and to the Diocese as Vicar for Missionary Discipleship, God may, in spite of my own weaknesses. brina people a greater to understanding of our shared ministry and united goal of building up the Kingdom.

God bless you all, and God bless our priests.

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION FOR ADULTS



The celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation for adults will be held on Sunday, November 24, at 4:00pm at Saint Columba Cathedral. This is a special opportunity for anyone (age 18 or older) who has not received the

sacrament to join with other adults of the diocese.

Candidates must register with our parish and be eligible to receive the sacrament by verifying baptism and marital status. A preparation program will be held at our parish. Sponsors must be a baptized, confirmed, practicing Catholic and may not be the candidate's parent.


