

### CHANGES IN THE CHURCH

Beginning the weekend of June 1st & 2nd, we will be re-instituting the distribution of the Precious Blood along with the Body of Christ at all our weekend Masses - the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. In preparation for this, and for a few other reasons, we will be making a few physical changes to the front portion of the Church. Beginning next weekend, the small section of pews in front of the Holy Family will be redesigned for those who are physically challenged. I addressed this many months ago in the bulletin. This space is closest to the accessible entrance and the accessible restrooms. The section in the front will be restored with the extra pews we have on hand at this time. We are in the process of obtaining a final quote for new pews and kneelers for the center sections of the Church. Additionally, the small section of pews in front of the tabernacle will be removed to make ready for a small Saint Michael Shrine area to be dedicated on the Feast Day in September. I realize that some people will be less than happy that they have been "displaced" from their seats, but we have more than enough room in the body of the Church for everyone. Thank you in advance for your understanding.

### FROM THE PASTOR . . .

In my homily last weekend, I spoke about how each of the Easter Sacraments (of Initiation) contain both an ending and a beginning. For each, the preparation process comes to an end, but having celebrated the sacrament, one is now called to begin a life more deeply rooted in God's grace and love. I also spoke about the conclusion of our Youth Faith Formation program, and how although last Sunday was the end of one year, we have already begun plans for the new year to begin in September. The same is true for our Order of Christian Initiation of Adults process. Those who became one with us in the Easter Sacraments at the Easter Vigil have experienced the end of an extensive process to become Catholic, and now they are invited by God's grace to actively live that faith each day. Like the youth program, plans will now begin for the next season of OCIA and Adult Faith Formation. One of the endings - but new beginnings, to be experienced is a retirement. This past Monday, Maureen Hall, our Pastoral Associate for Adult Faith Formation, indicated that she would be retiring from her position here at Saint Michael Parish. Maureen has been a part of the Saint Michael family for nearly 30 years and has led a variety of ministries over that time, with liturgy, youth ministry, but most especially RCIA and Adult Faith Formation. She is an active member of a variety of diocesan councils and has been a great source of knowledge and wisdom for so many here in the parish and beyond. I certainly understand the desire to step back from full-time ministry and prepare for a new phase of life as she begins her retirement. With the conclusion of the catechetical year, it seems the best time for Maureen to make the change. We will honor Maureen for her years of dedicated service to the parish at the 11:30am Mass on Sunday, June 2nd, and celebrate her retirement at the Ice Cream Social to follow. Thank you, Maureen, for your blessings to our parish family and enjoy your welldeserved retirement.
