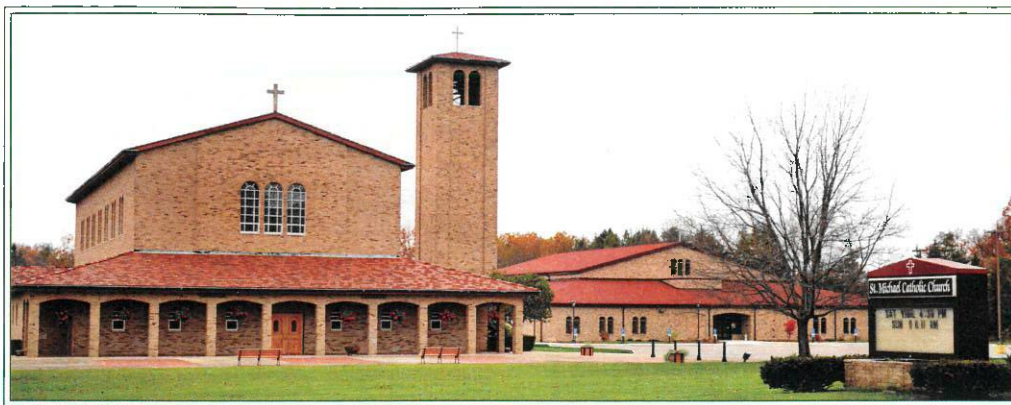

Mass will begin at 11:30am – celebrating the feast of Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini – the first US citizen to become a saint, followed by lunch and then the presentation. The form must be completed and include the \$10 stipend. This is the best way to adhere to the prescribed laws and be fair to everyone. Thank you.

## MISLEADING FACTS ABOUT ISSUE 1

### Vote NO by November 7

The Catholic Church supports and defends women, children, and vulnerable Ohioans through accompaniment, social services, and material assistance. A misleading amendment on the ballot this November suggests that a "right to abortion" is needed to protect women and children, while the amendment would actually put women at risk and endanger preborn children.

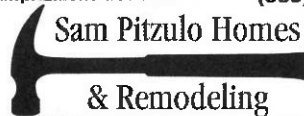
